### LETTER FROM THE EDITOR:

The first day of spring was March 19th. Spring signifies new beginnings.

In the Northern Hemisphere, the spring equinox in the Northern Hemisphere (also called the March equinox or vernal equinox across the globe) occurs when the Sun crosses the celestial equator going south to north. It's called the "celestial" equator because it's an imaginary line in the sky above the Earth's equator.

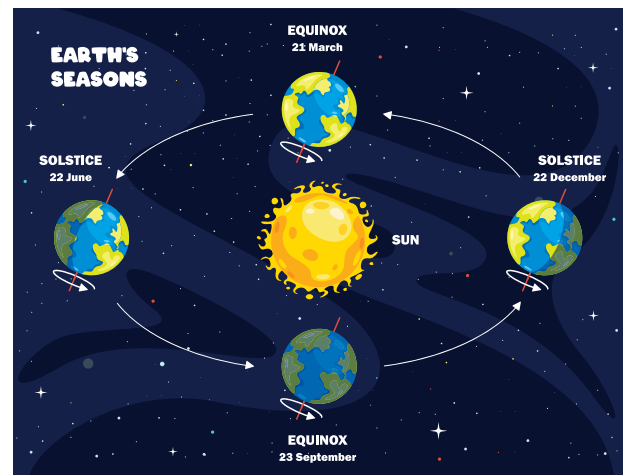
On the March equinox, the Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere receive roughly equal amounts of sunlight; neither hemisphere is tilted more toward or away from the Sun than the other. Although in most locations (the North Pole and Equator being exceptions), the amount of daylight had been increasing each day after the Winter Solstice.

After the spring equinox, many places will experience more daylight than darkness on each 24-hour day. The amount of daylight each day will continue to increase until the summer solstice in June, during which the longest period of daylight occurs.

Here's an interesting fact: Equinoxes are the only two times yearly that the Sun rises due east and sets due west for all of us on Earth! While the Sun passes overhead, the tilt of the Earth is zero relative to the Sun, which means that the Earth's axis neither points toward nor away from the Sun. (Note, however, that the Earth never orbits upright but is always tilted on its axis by about 23.5 degrees.)

The word *equinox* comes from the Latin words for "equal night"—*aequus* (equal) and *nox* (night). On the equinox, the length of day and night is nearly equal in all parts of the world.

Astronomically speaking, the first day of spring is marked by the spring equinox, which falls on March 19, 20, or 21 every year. The equinox happens at the exact moment worldwide, although our clock times reflect a different time zone. And, as mentioned above, this date only signals spring's beginning in the Northern Hemisphere; it announces fall's arrival in the Southern Hemisphere.



Interestingly, due to time zone differences, there hasn't been a March 21 equinox in mainland U.S. during the entire 21st century! We won't see a March 21 equinox again until 2101.

With spring comes warmer weather which allows us all to get outside, take walks, and enjoy the budding trees and our community. Take a look at our newsletter where you will find events, trips, and activities happening.

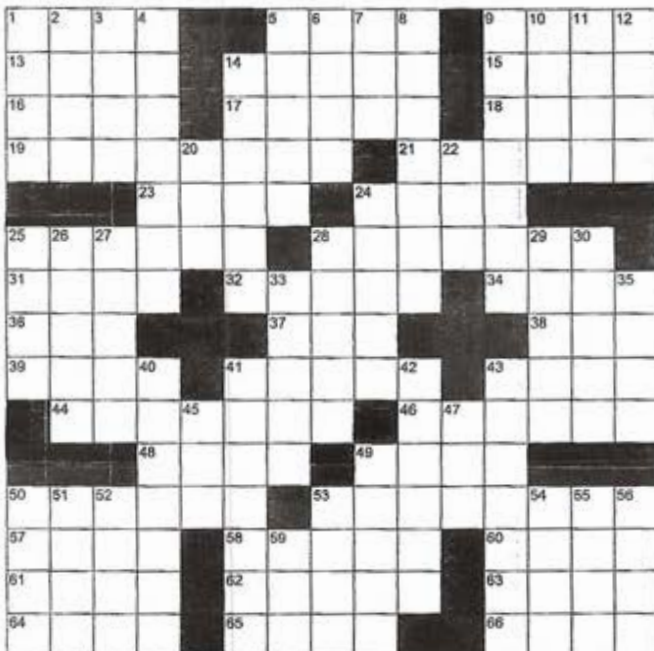

## From the Village Management Office:

# Spring is here!

**T**his is a great time to plan outdoor chores and home improvement projects. Below are some items to consider:

- Power wash dirt and mold off home siding, gutters, and downspouts.
- Sheds: repair or replace rotten wood; apply a fresh coat of paint, power wash dirt and mold off.
- Trees shrubs, and flower beds: prune and remove all dead plant material; replace anything dead or dying; apply fresh mulch.
- Lawns: clean up any old leaves or sticks that may have blown over the winter. Begin regular cuttings to keep Spring growth maintained.
- Shutters, doors, porches, and decks: power wash or apply a fresh coat of paint to any areas that may be chipping or peeling.
- Broken windows and torn screens: repair or replace as needed.
- Store unsightly items around the home out of site in your garage or shed (ladders, bikes, wheelbarrows, garden tools, etc.).
- The access panel should be secured and in good clean condition.
- Caulk any cracks in the blockwall and/or walkway.

All exterior home improvements or changes such as color, awnings, patios, patio covers or enclosures, decks, walkways, etc. must be approved by Management. Drawings, specifications, and/or color choices must be submitted for approval before starting your project. Appropriate township approval and permits must also be obtained if required. Please provide a copy of the executed township permit to the management office for our records. If you have questions about whether or not your project requires a permit, please call the building and zoning department at the township building.

The pool will be opening on May 25th for the season. Pool hours will be Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 12 pm – 8 pm and Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday, and Sunday from 11 am – 7 pm. As a reminder, residents must show their Village ID card to gain access to the pool.

Enclosed in this newsletter is an insert with instructions for purchasing pool passes. We will use the same request form as last year and passes will be mailed to your home address. See the insert for details.

The office and maintenance staff will be off starting at noon on Friday, March 29th for Good Friday and on May 27th for Memorial Day.

Trash will be picked up one day later than usual during the week of May 27th due to the holiday. Trash and recycling will be picked up on Wednesday, May 29th.

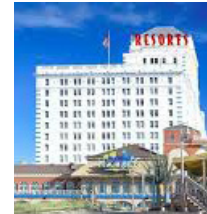

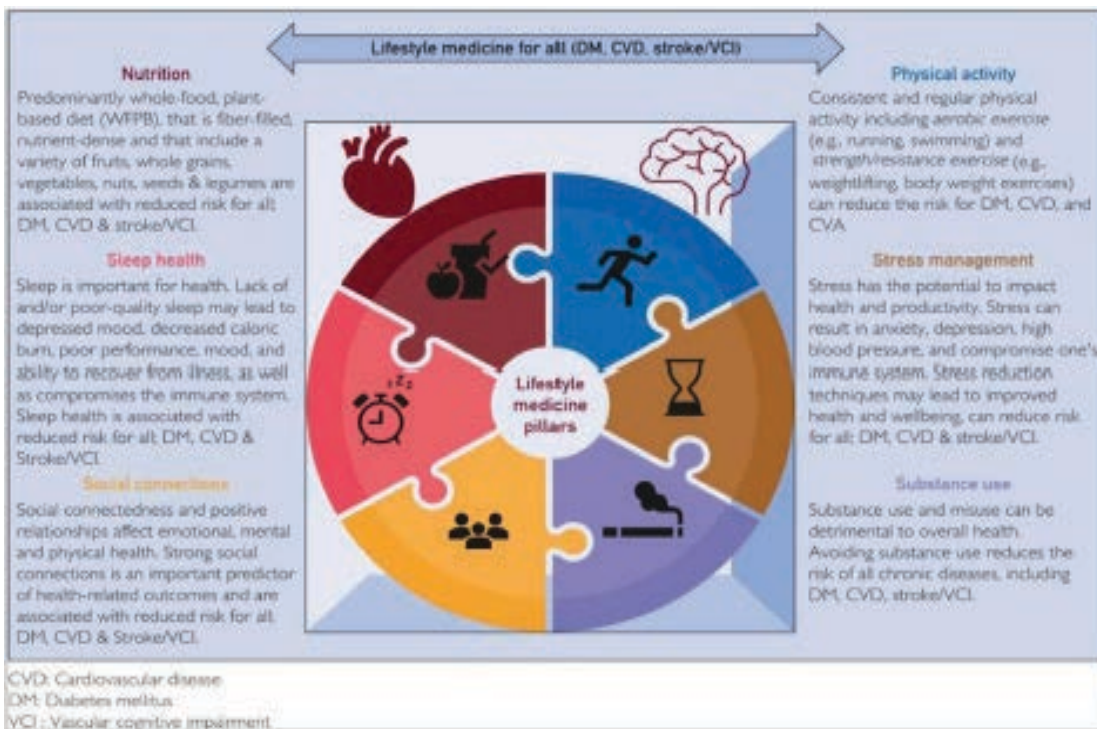

**L**ifestyle Medicine (LM) is a discipline that focuses on the role of lifestyle factors in preventing, managing, and reversing chronic disease. There are 6 pillars of LM; a whole-food, plant-predominant eating pattern, physical activity, restorative sleep, stress management, avoidance of risky substances, and positive social connections, are central in the creation and maintenance of health. Lifestyle Medicine works to treat the whole person by employing lifestyle change. Using the 6 pillars to help treat and prevent the root causes of many conditions. It places the patient, not medications or procedural treatments, at the center. Thus, it borrows and develops skills from multiple disciplines, such as nutrition science, positive psychology, behavior change, health and wellness coaching, exercise physiology, addiction medicine, and sleep medicine, with an ultimate focus on the health of both the patient and the Lifestyle Medicine clinician. The goal is to establish this philosophy as a bedrock and foundation of primary care, exposing healthcare professionals to the education and tools necessary to improve the well-being of themselves and their patients.



There is a need to incorporate into our focus lifestyle medicine, not only to prevent but also to treat cardiovascular disease (CVD), and other chronic conditions through effective lifestyle strategies. A vast majority of cardiovascular risk factors and established CVD can be approached through the 6 lifestyle pillars utilizing a lifestyle-first or lifestyle-plus pharmacologic and procedural treatment plan at both the family physician and cardiovascular specialty levels. With constructive

and cooperative partnerships between the public, healthcare professionals, educational institutions, health insurance agencies, and policymakers, this paradigm shift will be brought about in the interest of national health.

With each Buckingham Springs Newsletter, educational information related to establishing an improved well-being to promote health and prevent disease will be shared.

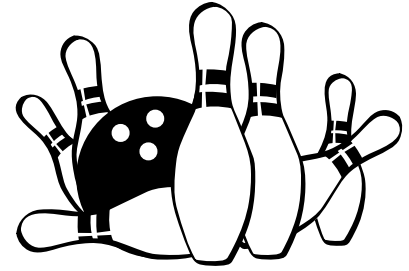
## CORNHOLE

The Circle of Friends, a Buckingham Springs volunteer group that welcomes new residents to the community and gives a helping to those in need, is kicking off quarterly information sessions about topics of interest or seniors.

The first session will be held at 11am on Monday, June 10 and will explore recent scams and how to avoid being swindled by con-artists. It is anticipated that a representative from the Buckingham Police Department will speak.

Other topics will explore in-home and community care offered by St. Mary Medical Center, county-run programs for seniors, and little-known state operated benefits. Topics are yet to be confirmed, but the dates for the rest of this year are: September 23, at 7 p.m. and December 9, at 11am. Light refreshments will be served.

The series is called "Here's The Skinny...." Maryann Vagas, one of seven neighborhood leaders with the Circle of Friends, will plan the events.

The Circle of Friends was organized in 2022 to welcome new residents with a small gift and provide temporary assistance to those who need support. It also reaches out to community members with sympathy or get well cards. It is self-funded through an annual "End of Summer Raffle Basket."

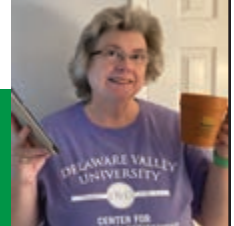

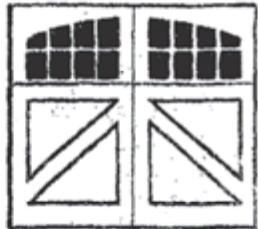
